



GRS Certification for Final Products Policy

The following GRS-105 policy is introduced to supplement criteria and site auditing applicability for sites handling GRS certified final products without further processing.

Section A – General Information

Al. Implementation

- A1.1 The following implementation timelines apply:
 - A1.1.1 The *GRS Certification for Final Products Policy 4.1* is effective March 27, 2023, and may be used immediately.
 - A1.1.2 All audits and assessments conducted on or after March 27, 2023, shall be conducted using *GRS Certification for Final Products Policy 4.1*.
- NOTE: GRS-*105-v4.0* is the earliest version of this document in order to align with the versions of the Global Recycled Standard (*GRS-101*).

Section B – Applicability of GRS Certification Criteria

B1. Identification of Organizations Purchasing Final Products

- **B1.1** An organization may be considered to be purchasing exclusively GRS certified *final products* if <u>all</u> of the following criteria apply:
 - **B1.1.1** All of the organization's sites which are included on the scope certificate are <u>not</u> processing claimed materials, except as allowed by B1.1.3, and instead are limited to processing categories PR0000 (no processing), PR0025 (retail), PR0030 (trading), PR0031 (warehousing and distribution), and/or PR0035 (brand).
 - **B1.1.2** All *claimed material* inputs for GRS are final products, which will be sold to the *consumer* in their current state and without further processing except as allowed by B1.1.3.
 - **B1.1.3** Processing which is minor in nature (see *CCS-201-v3.1B1.5*) is permitted, provided that there is no application of chemicals (e.g. printing).

B2. Applicability of GRS Modules

- **B2.1** Any organization purchasing exclusively GRS certified final products is <u>not</u> required to meet or be audited to Sections B (Social Requirements), C (Environmental Requirements), and D (Chemical Requirements) of the *GRS-101-v4.0*.
- **B2.2** The criteria of the *CCS-101 Content Claim Standard* and of the *TE-301 Standards Claims Policy* remain applicable to organizations purchasing exclusively GRS certified final products. Refer to *CCS-101-v3.1*, section B1 for details on when the organization is required to be certified.
